Day 1 – Monday, July 18: Depart U.S.A. Depart the United States on your overnight flight to Poland.

Day 2 – Tuesday, July 19: Krakow / Izdebnik

Upon arrival in Krakow you will be met at the airport by your local tour manager. Board your coach and transfer to your hostel in Izdebnik which is located a short distance from Krakow.

≫ Day 3 – Wednesday, July 20: Czestochowa / Auschwitz

After breakfast, travel to the Nazi concentration camp of Auschwitz where millions were killed during World War II including St. Maximillian Kolbe who starved after volunteering his life for that of a fellow prisoner. Then proceed to Czestochowa which is the most popular pilgrimage site in Poland. Here you will visit the Jasna Gora Monastery and see the Treasury, the Knight's Hall, the Refectory and the Basilica of the Holy Cross and the Nativity of the Virgin Mary. The highlight of your visit will be a viewing of the famous icon



of the Black Madonna to which miraculous powers are attributed. Return to your hostel in Izdebnik for overnight.

➢ Day 4 − Thursday, July 21: Wadowice

After breakfast, drive to Wadowice to visit the birthplace of Pope John Paul II. Here you will visit his childhood home which is now a museum and the Church of the Presentation of the Virgin Mary where he was baptized. After Mass in Wadowice, proceed to Kalwaria Zebrzydowska, the "Polish Jerusalem," which was a popular pilgrimage place for Pope John Paul II when he was a young man and where in the 17th century the Palatine of Krakow founded a monastery. On the slope of the hill and the valley is an architectural 'Way of the Cross' made up of 40 chapels set on the surrounding hills. Return to your hostel in Izdebnik for overnight.



> Day 5 - Friday, July 22: Zakopane / Nowy Targ / Izdebnik Today we will enjoy an excursion to Zakopane, Poland's winter capital in the Tatras. Celebrate Mass at Fatima Church, which was built by the mountaineers in gratitude for the Blessed Mother saving the life of Pope John Paul II from the assassination attempt. Then take the funicular to Mt. Kasprowy for a bird's eye view over the city and hillsides of Zakopane. Then return to Zakopane and enjoy some free

time to wander the town and shop on Krupowki Street. Then depart Zakopane and drive to Nowy Targ to visit the home parish of Fr. Marcin Garbacz before returning to your hostel

Izdebnik for overnight.

> Day 6 - Saturday, July 23: Debno / Dunajec River

After breakfast drive to celebrate Mass at Archangel Michael's Church in Debno, which was built with larchwood and joined by notching and reinforced with spiles, but

with no nails. After Mass, continue to the start point for your rafting journey along the Dunajec River, enjoying the



panorama of the Czorsztynski Reservoir, Niedzica Castle and the Tatras along the way. Your raft trip down the

Dunajec River will take you through the Pieniny Gorge and along the Polish-Slovak border, which is one of the greatest tourist attractions in Poland. The towering cliffs and the

limestone rock formations of the gorge, plus the picturesque mountain scenery, the surrounding national forest, and the colorful river guides make for a wonderful day in a pristine

and wild environment. While cruising down the river, enjoy excellent views of the high summits while you relax in the shadow of Poland's majestic mountains. At the conclusion of

your rafting trip you will return to your hostel in Izdebnik for overnight.

Day 7 - Sunday, July 24: Wieliczka

After breakfast, drive to Wieliczka to visit Europe's oldest salt

mine which has been listed by UNESCO as a World Heritage Site. The mines are a unique place where many generations of Polish miners have created a world of underground chambers and decorated chapels carved out of salt including the famous Chapel of St. Kinga. Return to Izdebnik to visit the home parish of Fr. Andrzej Wyrostek. Overnight at your hostel in Izdebnik.

Day 8 - Monday, July 25: Izdebnik / Krakow

Following breakfast, drive to Krakow and proceed to Wawel Hill and visit the Cathedral of St. Stanislaw, Poland's second most important pilgrimage shrine, and the Royal Castle which is one of the most beautiful renaissance residences in central Europe. Continue to Krakow's Old Town to see the main Market Square, the Church of St. Mary, Cloth Hall, City Hall Tower, Kanonicza Street where Pope John Paul II resided while living in Krakow and the courtyard of the

> Day 14 - Sunday, July 31: Krakow

This morning you will participate in the WYD closing ceremonies with include prayers led by the participating Bishops and Mass celebrated by Pope Francis. The remainder of the afternoon will be free. This evening enjoy a farewell dinner at a local restaurant.

> Day 15 - Monday, August 1: Krakow / U.S.A.

This morning you will transfer to the airport in Krakow to catch your return flight home.







Collegium Maius where he was a student. Then proceed to the Divine Mercy Shrine in Lagiewniki, where Saint Faustina, the Apostle of Divine Mercy, lived and died. Enjoy a guided tour of the shrine and celebrate Mass at the Blessed John Paul II Chapel. Afterwards visit the Blessed John Paul II Center, where the Blessed John Paul II's relics may be venerated. Proceed to register for WYD and then transfer to your simple accommodations in Krakow.

> Day 9 - Tuesday, July 26: Krakow

This morning is free. In the afternoon you will participate in the WYD welcome ceremonies which include the opening Mass which is celebrated by the local ordinary of the host diocese. This evening there will be shows, music, prayer and reconciliation opportunities.

Day 10 - Wednesday, July 27: Krakow

This morning you will participate in the WYD catechetical sessions scheduled for the day. This afternoon and evening there will be shows, music, prayer and reconciliation opportunities.

➢ Day 11 - Thursday, July 28: Krakow

This morning you will participate in the WYD catechetical sessions scheduled for the day. In the afternoon Pope Francis will deliver his welcome address at a prayer service. This evening there will be shows, music, prayer and reconciliation opportunities.

> Day 12 - Friday, July 29: Krakow

This morning you will participate in the WYD catechetical sessions scheduled for the day. This afternoon there will be shows, music, prayer and reconciliation opportunities. In the evening we will participate in the Stations of the Cross.

> Day 13 - Saturday, July 30: Krakow

This morning will be free. In the afternoon there will be

Reservations and Payment: For this pilgrimage, Tekton Ministries requires a deposit of \$300.00 per person at the time of booking, an additional deposit of \$1000 by June 1st, 2015, and a further deposit of \$1000 by December 31, 2015. These deposits form a part of your final payment, the balance of which is due by April 15th, 2016. Reservations made within 90 days of departure must be accompanied by payment in full. Payments made by credit card will incur a convenience fee of 4%. Any reservations received within 45 days of departure will incur a late booking fee of \$100.00 per person. This pilgrimage is based upon a minimum of 32 total pilgrims. Surcharges may be assessed for a smaller group size.

Cancellations: All cancellations must be in writing. The following per person cancellation charges will apply in addition to any charges incurred by our suppliers: If canceled 91 days or more prior to departure, a \$50.00 administrative fee will be charged. If canceled 90 - 31 days prior to departure, \$150.00 will be charged. If canceled 30 - 15 days prior to departure, \$450.00 will be charged. If canceled 14 - 7 days prior to departure \$70.00 will be charged. No refunds will be made within 6 days of departure. In addition, once the airline tickets have been issued, 100% of the airfare is non-refundable unless you have been advised otherwise at the time of your booking.

Travel Documents: A passport which is valid for 6 months past the date of your return flight home is required of all U. S. citizens. However, U.S. citizens do not require visas for Poland. If you are not a U.S. citizen, please call to find out if you need a visa. Tekton Ministries is not responsible for individual visas or passports.

Accomodations: We will be staying a hostel in Izdebnik from July 19th - 25th. During World Youth Day we will be using the more simple group accomodation assigned to us.

Air Transportation: Air travel is in economy class, to be decided once the pilgrimage comes into ticketing range. Fares are based upon levels in effect at the time of printing and fares and flight schedules are subject to change without notice.

Baggage: Each passenger is allowed one checked bag and one carryon. Tekton Ministries is not responsible for lost, damaged or stolen baggage.

Travel Insurance: We strongly recommend that you purchase comprehensive travel insurance for your trip. Registration information will be provided upon receipt of your deposit.

Not Included: Passport/visa fees, personal travel insurance, laundry, beverages and items not on the regular menu of included meals, excess baggage charges, optional sightseeing and expenses of a personal nature.

Refunds: Subject to the foregoing Cancellation Terms, upon cancellation of travel related services, all sums paid to Tekton Ministries/George's International Tours for such services will be promptly returned to the passenger, provided the passenger has not caused such cancellation and is not in violation of any of the terms and conditions previously, clearly and conspicuously disclosed and agreed to by the passenger. This refund provision does not apply where Tekton Ministries/George's International Tours has remitted the payment to another registered seller of travel or a carrier and they default in providing the agreed-upon transportation or service

- without providing a refund. In such a situation, Tekton Ministries/ George's International Tours agrees to provide passenger with a written statement accompanied by a copy of the bank records
- establishing the disbursement of the payment, and if disbursed to a
 - seller of travel, proof of their current registration.
- Trust Account Disclosure: California law requires certain sellers of travel to have a trust account or bond. George's International Tours
- has such a trust account. Travel Consumer Restitution Corporation ("TCRC"): George's
- International Tours is a participant in the Travel Consumer Restitution Corporation ("TCRC"). You, the passenger, may request reimbursement from TCRC if George's International Tours was registered and participating in the TCRC at the time of sale and the passenger is legated in California at the time of sale and the passenger is located in California at the time of payment. - be advised that passengers purchasing from outside of California are not covered by the TCRC. Eligible passengers may file a claim

- must include sufficient information and documentation to prove your claim and a \$35 processing fee. You must agree to waive your
- right to other civil remedies against a registered participating Seller of Travel for matters arising out of a sale for which you file a claim
- with the TCRC, if you were located in California at the time of the
- sale. You may request a claim form by writing to: Travel Consumer Restitution Corporation, P.O. Box 6001, Larkspur, CA 94977-6001; or by faxing a request to 415-927-7698.
