




Depart the United States on your overnight flight to Prague.

Day 2: Saturday, July 23: Arrival in PragueArrival in Prague with an afternoon at leisure.
Dinner at the hotel. (D)

➢ Day 3: Sunday, July 24: Prague

Today we will enjoy a full day tour of Prague, starting with a visit to the Castle District featuring Royal Castle, St. Vitus Cathedral, St. George Basilica and the Golden Lane. Then proceed to



the Church of St. Nicholas and then the Church of Our Lady of Victory where we will see the famous statue of the Infant Jesus of Prague. After Mass, we will continue across the Charles Bridge to visit the Old Town Square with its famous astronomical clock, the Tyn Church and the Jewish Quarter. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Prague. (B/D)

Day 4: Monday, July 25: Prague / Krakow
 This morning, after breakfast we leave Prague

for Krakow. En route we will stop in Wadowice, the birthplace of Pope John Paul II. Visit his family house which is now a museum and the church where Karol Wojtyla was baptized and



attended Masses as a child and later as a teenager. Continue to Krakow to check-in to our WYD accommodations. Dinner at the hotel. (B/D)

Day 5: Tuesday, July 26: Krakow – WorldYouth Day Opening Mass

Guided tour of Krakow, including entrance to Wawel Castle and visit the Basilica of Saint Mary

(Mariacki) and remember St. Faustina's prayer

for Divine Mercy. Evening participation in theopening of the World Youth Day in Krakow with

the Cardinal Archbishop of Krakow. (B)

➢ Day 7: July 28: Thursday, World Youth Day



Day 8: Friday, July 29: World Youth Day

The sessions will take place in churches, schools, auditoriums and sports centers in Krakow. Take part in the Stations of the Cross. (B)





➢ Day 9: Saturday, July 30: World Youth Day
Young people will arrive at the site for the vigil.
The pope will arrive and Eucharistic adoration
will begin. An address is made by the Holy
Father. Overnight vigil. (B)

> Day 10: Sunday, July 31: World Youth Day

The Pope will concelebrate Mass with thousands of bishops and priests. He will address the young people, to send them out to the world to witness to their faith, as the Lord did with his Apostles. At the end of the Mass, the Holy Father will announce the location where the next World Youth Day will be held. Culmination of World Youth Day 2016. (B)

Day 11: Monday, August 1: Depart for Home Following breakfast, transfer to the airport for return flight home. (B)

These rates include:

- * Roundtrip economy class airfare from Chicago O'Hare to Prague and return from Prague to Chicago O'Hare
- * Airline taxes/fuel surcharges (as currently levied but subject to change)
- * Bus transfers from Indianapolis to Chicago airport (and return)
- * Accommodation for 2 nights in Prague at the Andel's Hotel and 7 nights in Krakow at the Felix Hotel
- * Meals as per itinerary (B = Breakfast, L = Lunch, D = Dinner)
- * Professional tour manager from July 23-August 1
- * Comprehensive sightseeing with professional local guides (1 full day guide in Prague, 1 halfday guide in Krakow)
- * All entrance fees as per itinerary
- * Land transportation by private motorcoach from July 23-26
- * Departure transfer from Krakow hotel to Prague airport by private motorcoach on August 1

These rates do not include:

- * WYD registration fees including meal package and transportation (\$165 added to final invoice)
- * Half-day Auschwitz excursion (pending final confirmation and date \$55)
- * Balance of any air taxes/fuel surcharges above the included amounts
- * Motorcoach services in Krakow from July 27-31
- * Gratuities to tour manager, local guides, drivers and hotel/restaurant staff
- * Travel insurance (mandatory per Archdiocesan offices)
- * Lunches, drinks with meals, extras at hotels and any expenses of a personal nature

Reservations and Payment: For this pilgrimage, Tekton Ministries requires a deposit of \$300.00 per person by June 15th, 2015, and an additional deposit of \$1000 by January 30th, 2016. These deposits form a part of your final payment, the balance of which is due by April 1st, 2016. Reservations made after this deadline must be accompanied by payment in full. Payments made by credit card will incur a convenience fee of 4%. Any reservations received within 120 days of departure will incur a late booking fee of \$100.00 per person. This pilgrimage is based upon a minimum of 36 total pilgrims per bus. Surcharges may be assessed for a smaller group size.

Cancellations: All cancellations must be in writing. The following per person cancellation charges will apply in addition to any charges incurred by our suppliers: if canceled between 1/1/16 and 3/15/16, a \$350.00 fee will be charged. If canceled between 3/16/16 and 4/20/16, \$850.00 will be charged. If canceled between 4/21/16 and 6/21/16, \$1500.00 will be charged. If canceled between 6/22/16 and 7/13/16, \$2000.00 will be charged. No refunds will be made after 7/13/16. In addition, once the airline tickets have been issued, 100% of the airfare is non-refundable unless you have been advised otherwise at the time of your booking.

Travel Documents: A passport which is valid for 6 months past the date of your return flight home is required of all U. S. citizens. However, U.S. citizens do not require visas for Poland or the Czech Republic. If you are not a U.S. citizen, please call to find out if you need a visa. Tekton Ministries is not responsible for individual visas or passports.

Accomodations: In Prague you will be staying in a 4-star hotel. In Krakow you will be staying in a 3-star hotel.

Air Transportation: Air travel is in economy class on Delta Airlines/ KLM. Fares are based upon levels in effect at the time of printing and fares and flight schedules are subject to change without notice. Note that any ticketing changes made within 90 days of your departure date will incur airline penalties.

Baggage: Each passenger is allowed one checked bag and one carryon. Tekton Ministries is not responsible for lost, damaged or stolen baggage.

Travel Insurance: The Archdiocese requires that you purchase comprehensive travel insurance for your trip. More information can be found on the Tekton Ministries website. Options will be available by attending one of the Archdiocesan meetings prior to making your final payment. Registration information will be provided upon receipt of your deposit.

Not Included: World Youth Day registration fees and meal package, passport/visa fees, balance of airline taxes/fuel surcharges above the amount currently levied, personal travel insurance, laundry, gratuities (to tour manager, local guides, drivers and hotel/restaurant staff), beverages, and items not on the regular menu of included meals, excess baggage charges, optional sightseeing and expenses of a personal nature.

Refunds: Subject to the foregoing Cancellation Terms, upon cancellation of travel related services, all sums paid to Tekton Ministries/George's International Tours for such services will be promptly returned to the passenger, <u>provided</u> the passenger has not caused such cancellation and is not in violation of any of the terms and conditions previously, clearly and conspicuously disclosed and agreed to by the passenger. This refund provision does not apply where Tekton Ministries/George's International Tours has remitted the payment to another registered seller of travel or a carrier and they default in providing the agreed-upon transportation or service

- without providing a refund. In such a situation, Tekton Ministries/ George's International Tours agrees to provide passenger with
- a written statement accompanied by a copy of the bank records establishing the disbursement of the payment, and if disbursed to a
- seller of travel, proof of their current registration.
- **Trust Account Disclosure:** California law requires certain sellers of travel to have a trust account or bond. George's International Tours has such a trust account.

Travel Consumer Restitution Corporation ("TCRC"): George's International Tours is a participant in the Travel Consumer Restitution Corporation ("TCRC"). You, the passenger, may request reimbursement from TCRC if George's International Tours was registered and participant in the TCRC at the time of sale and the passenger is located in California at the time of payment. Please be advised that passengers purchasing from outside of California are not covered by the TCRC. Eligible passengers may file a claim with TCRC if the passenger is owed a refund of more than \$50 for transportation or travel services which George's International Tours failed to forward to a proper provider or if such money was not refunded to you when required. The maximum amount, which may be paid by the TCRC to any one passenger is the total amount paid on behalf of the passenger to George's International Tours, not to exceed \$15,000. A claim must be submitted to the TCRC within six months after the scheduled completion date of the travel. A claim must include sufficient information and documentation to prove your claim and a \$35 processing fee. You must agree to waive your right to other civil remedies against a registered participating Seller of Travel for matters arising out of a sale for which you file a claim with the TCRC, if you were located in California at the time of the sale. You may request a claim form by writing to: Travel Consumer Restitution Corporation, P.O. Box 6001, Larkspur, CA 94977-6001; or by faxing a request to 415-927-7698.

Responsibility Clause: Tekton Ministries, George's International Tours and/or their cooperating selling agents and/or their suppliers of services offer these tours for sale only on the express understanding that they themselves do not perform or in any way assume liability for the performance of the individual components, transfers, hotels, flights, car, motorcoaches, etc. of these tours and act only to combine these components into a single unit of sale for the convenience of the general public, and are not responsible therefore, either directly or indirectly, for any loss, accident, or injury which may result from any act, omission, negligence in or responsible for performing or providing these component services. The transportation companies concerned take no responsibility for any act, omission, or event during the time the passengers are not aboard their conveyances. The passenger contract issued by the transportation company shall constitute the sole contract between the transportation company and the passenger. Additional expenses incurred as a result of delay, change of schedules, illness, weather, strikes, hostilities, quarantine, government requisition of hotel space or any other reasons beyond the control of the tour operator or travel agent shall be borne by the passenger.
