



➢ Day 1 − Thursday, July 21: Depart U.S.A. Depart the United States on our overnight flight to • Rome.

→ Day 2 – Friday, July 22: Arrive Rome After arrival in the "Eternal City", we will be met at • the airport and transfer to our hotel for overnight. (D)

➢ Day 3 – Saturday, July 23: Rome We'll begin our day in Rome with Mass in St. Peter's Basilica, followed by a tour including the Pieta and Adoration Chapel which St. John Paul II opened in 1981. Our guide will then take us through the Vatican • Museum and the Sistine Chapel with its awesome



frescoes painted by Michelangelo focusing especially on Eucharistic art and artifacts. As we exit the chapel we will walk through the Holy Doors of St. Peter's Basilica and receive the Year of Mercy blessing. In the afternoon you will have time for prayer at one of the many chapels of St. Peter's Basilica and shop for souvenirs around the Vatican. In the evening we will visit the Pantheon and the Piazza Navona with Bernini's famous fountains. (B/D)

➢ Day 4 − Sunday, July 24: Rome This morning our pilgrimage begins with a visit to St. Mary Major Basilica where we will celebrate Mass. Our Redemptorist Order and the Church of St. Alphonsus • of Krakow. (B)



Liguori which houses the original icon of Our Lady of Perpetual Help. Later visit St. John Lateran, and the Holy Stairs, followed by a visit to the Church of Santa Croce in Gerusalemme which contains relics of the Crucifixion. This evening we will walk to the Spanish Steps and the Trevi Fountain, where a coin thrown over your shoulder will guarantee you another visit to Rome. (B/D)

Day 5: Monday, July 25: Warsaw / Krakow This morning we begin our day at St. Paul Outside the Walls which was originally built by Constantine in the fourth century over the site of St. Paul's tomb, where we will celebrate Mass. Next visit the Old



Appian Way and the St. Sebastian Catacombs, the famous underground cemetery. Then in the afternoon transfer to the airport to catch our flight to Warsaw. Upon arrival in Warsaw we will transfer to Krakow for check-in to our WYD accommodations. (B)

Day 6: Tuesday, July 26: Krakow − World Youth Day - Opening Mass

Guided tour of Krakow, including entrance to Wawel Castle and visit the Basilica of Saint Mary (Mariacki) and remember St. Faustina's prayer for Divine Mercy. Evening participation in the opening of the World day will also include a visit to the Mother House of the • Youth Day in Krakow with the Cardinal Archbishop

➢ Day 7: Wednesday, July 27: Krakow – WYD

Morning Catechesis and World Youth Day Activities. WYD participants, organized by language groups, will have catechesis session with bishops from all over the world. The sessions will take place in churches, schools, auditoriums and sports centers in Krakow. (B)

➢ Day 9: Friday, July 29: Krakow – WYD

Morning Catechesis and World Youth Day Activities. WYD participants, organized by language groups, will have catechesis session with bishops from all over the world. The sessions will take place in churches, schools, auditoriums and sports centers in Krakow. Take part in the Stations of the Cross. (B)

Day 10: Saturday, July 30: Krakow – WYD

Young people will arrive at the site for the vigil. The pope will arrive and Eucharistic adoration will begin. An address is may by the Holy Father. Overnight vigil. (B)

➢ Day 11: Sunday, July 31: Krakow – WYD

The Pope will concelebrate Mass with thousands of bishops and priests, and he will address the young people, to send them out to the world to witness to their faith, as the Lord did with his Apostles. At the end of the Mass, the Holy Father will announce the place where the next edition of World Youth Day will be held. Culmination of World Youth Day 2016. (B)

➢ Day 12: Monday, August 1: Krakow / Prague or Vienna / U.S.A.

Late night transfer to the airport for return flight home.



- * Accommodation for 3 nights in Rome at the Nova Domus Hotel or similar and 7 nights in Krakow at the Felix Hotel or similar
- * Meals as per itinerary
- * Professional tour manager in Rome from July 22-25
- * Professional tour manager in Krakow from July 25 August 1
- * Comprehensive sightseeing with professional local guides (2 full day guides and 1 half day guide in Rome, 1 halfday guide in Krakow)

Reservations and Payment: For this pilgrimage, Tekton Ministries requires a deposit of \$300.00 per person by June 15th, 2015, and an additional deposit of \$1000 by October 15th, 2015. These deposits form a part of your final payment, the balance of which is due by April 1st, 2016. Reservations made after this deadline must be accompanied by payment in full. Payments made by credit card will incur a convenience fee of 4%. Any reservations received within 120 days of departure will incur a late booking fee of \$100.00 per person. This pilgrimage is based upon a minimum of 32 total pilgrims per bus. Surcharges may be assessed for a smaller group size.

Cancellations: All cancellations must be in writing. The following per person cancellation charges will apply in addition to any charges incurred by our suppliers: if canceled between 1/1/16 and 3/15/16, a \$350.00 fee will be charged. If canceled between 3/16/16 and 4/20/16, \$850.00 will be charged. If canceled between 4/21/16 and 6/21/16, \$1500.00 will be charged. If canceled between 6/22/16 and 7/13/16, \$2000.00 will be charged. No refunds will be made after 7/13/16. In addition, once the airline tickets have been issued, 100% of the airfare is non-refundable unless you have been advised otherwise at the time of your booking.

Travel Documents: A passport which is valid for 6 months past the date of your return flight home is required of all U. S. citizens. However, U.S. citizens do not require visas for Poland or Italy. If you are not a U.S. citizen, please call to find out if you need a visa. Tekton Ministries is not responsible for individual visas or passports.

Accomodations: In both Rome and Poland we will be staying in 3-star hotels.

Air Transportation: Air travel is in economy class, on Swiss Air or Lufthansa, and Sabena. Fares are based upon levels in effect at the time of printing and fares and flight schedules are subject to change without notice. Note that any ticketing changes made within 90 days of your departure date will incur airline penalties.

Baggage: Each passenger is allowed one checked bag and one carryon. Tekton Ministries is not responsible for lost, damaged or stolen baggage.

Travel Insurance: The Archdiocese requires that you purchase comprehensive travel insurance for your trip. More information can be found on the Tekton Ministries website. Options will be available by attending one of the Archdiocesan meetings prior to making your final payment. Registration information will be provided upon receipt of your deposit.

Not Included: World Youth Day registration fees and meal package, passport/visa fees, balance of airline taxes/fuel surcharges above the amount currently levied, personal travel insurance, laundry, gratuities (to tour manager, local guides, drivers and hotel/restaurant staff), beverages, and items not on the regular menu of included meals, excess baggage charges, optional sightseeing and expenses of a personal nature.

Refunds: Subject to the foregoing Cancellation Terms, upon cancellation of travel related services, all sums paid to Tekton Ministries/George's International Tours for such services will be promptly returned to the passenger, <u>provided</u> the passenger has not caused such cancellation and is not in violation of any of the terms and conditions previously, clearly and conspicuously disclosed and agreed to by the passenger. This refund provision does not apply

where Tekton Ministries/George's International Tours has remitted the payment to another registered seller of travel or a carrier and they default in providing the agreed-upon transportation or service

they default in providing the agreed-upon transportation or service without providing a refund. In such a situation, Tekton Ministries/George's International Tours agrees to provide passenger with

George's International Tours agrees to provide passenger with a written statement accompanied by a copy of the bank records establishing the disbursement of the payment, and if disbursed to a seller of travel, proof of their current registration.

Trust Account Disclosure: California law requires certain sellers of travel to have a trust account or bond. George's International Tours has such a trust account.

Travel Consumer Restitution Corporation ("TCRC"): George's International Tours is a participant in the Travel Consumer Restitution Corporation ("TCRC"). You, the passenger, may request reimbursement from TCRC if George's International Tours was registered and participating in the TCRC at the time of sale and the passenger is located in California at the time of payment. Please be advised that passengers purchasing from outside of California are not covered by the TCRC. Eligible passengers may file a claim with TCRC if the passenger is owed a refund of more than \$50 for transportation or travel services which George's International Tours failed to forward to a proper provider or if such money was not refunded to you when required. The maximum amount, which may be paid by the TCRC to any one passenger is the total amount paid on behalf of the passenger to George's International Tours, not to exceed \$15,000. A claim must be submitted to the TCRC within six months after the scheduled completion date of the travel. A claim must include sufficient information and documentation to prove your claim and a \$35 processing fee. You must agree to waive your right to other civil remedies against a registered participating Seller of Travel for matters arising out of a sale for which you file a claim with the TCRC, if you were located in California at the time of the sale.
