> Pilgrimage Itinerary



➢ Day 1 − July 31: Depart U.S.A.

Our pilgrimage begins as we depart on our overnight flight to Florence. Meals and refreshments will be served aloft.

➢ Day 2 − August 1: Arrive Florence

After arrival in Florence, the regional capital of Tuscany, we will be met by our local tour manager and transfer to our centrally located hotel. Following Mass at a local church the balance of the day will be free.

≫ Day 3 – August 2: Florence

Our tour of Florence this morning is an artful experience as we take in the Ponte Vecchio, the Duomo, the Baptistery with its renowned bronze doors, the replica of the famous statue of David by Michelangelo outside the Palazzo Vecchio, Santa Maria Novella Church and Santa Croce Church. We will conclude the day with a visit to the convent and church of San Marco which during the 15th century was home to two famous Dominicans, the painter Fra Angelico and the preacher Girolamo Savonarola. The convent now contains a museum containing the works of



these painters which we will visit. The remainder of the afternoon for personal activities

➢ Day 4 − August 3: Florence

Today will be a free day during which time you may wish to visit one of Florence's world famous museums or just walk the beautiful streets and do some shopping.

Day 5 – August 4: Florence / Siena / Assisi

In the morning we will depart Florence and drive south to Siena, home of St. Catherine. Our first stop this morning and a highlight of our tour will be the Basilica of St. Francis where we'll venerate the Eucharistic miracle of Siena. Then we'll celebrate Mass at St. Dominic's, St. Catherine of Siena's parish church where she attended daily Mass and went into ecstasy. Adjacent to the church is her home, which we'll tour and see the cell where she fasted and prayed. Then we'll stroll the ancient Gothic streets which converge




on the Piazza del Campo, one of the most beautiful squares in the world where we can stop for lunch. We will then drive south through the beautiful Tuscan and Umbrian countryside to Assisi.

➢ Day 6 − August 5: Assisi

to for seclusion and prayer.

We will begin this morning with a visit to St. Mary of the Angels Basilica, site of the Porziuncola, the tiny church in the woods where St. Francis began his ministry and where St. Clare began her religious life. Then enjoy a sightseeing tour of Assisi including visits to the Convent of San Damiano where the miracle of the Eucharist of 1211 took place, the Basilica of St. Francis where we will celebrate Mass, and the Basilica of St. Clare. Continue on to the Rocca Maggiore, a castle which dominates the entire skyline with its impressive battlements. Then for those with the stamina, take a walk up Monte Subasio to L'Eremo delle Carceri (the Carceri Hermitage), the Saint's favorite retreat. There are many caves here that St. Francis and his followers retreated



Day 7 – August 6: Assisi / Cascia / Assisi

This morning we will head to Cascia, the home of Saint Rita, "the saint of the impossible". We'll visit her Basilica and view her incorrupt body and pray in the chapel containing the Eucharistic miracle of Cascia. After Mass there will be time for adoration. Then tour Saint Rita's convent where she received the thorn from Christ's crown. Return to Assisi where you will have the remainder of the afternoon free for personal activities.

→ Day 8 – August 7: Assisi / Orvieto / Rome

Depart Assisi this morning and drive south to Orvieto, home to Italy's most stunning Gothic Cathedral, where the Feast of Corpus Christi began. After a visit of the Cathedral of Orvieto and celebrating Mass, there will be time for prayer and adoration. See the steps of the Papal summer residence where Pope Urban IV held up the bloodstained corporal and announced his intention to institute

the Feast of Corpus Christi. Have some free time in the late afternoon to explore this beautiful town on your own. Proceed south to the "Eternal City" of Rome, our home for the next five nights.

≫ Day 9 – August 8: Rome

This morning we'll head to the Mamertine Prison (outside visit – currently closed) where St. Paul was kept in chains, view the Forum (outside visit) and Coliseum and stop at St. Clement's, to see the second century dwelling of Pope St. Clement, the third successor of St. Peter, and the original fresco depicting St. Clement celebrating the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass. This fresco gives us a picture of Eucharistic worship at the end of the first century or beginning of the second. Proceed to St. Peter in Chains featuring Michelangelo's "Moses", St. Paul Outside the Walls which was originally built by Constantine in the fourth century over the site of St. Paul's tomb where Mass

Way. Visit the St. Sebastian Catacombs where we will celebrate Mass. Afterwards we'll stop at the Basilica of San Andrea del Fratte, where Alphonse Ratisbonne was instantly converted when Our Lady appeared to him. This

instantly converted when Our Lady appeared to him. This is where St. Maximilian Kolbe said his first Mass and where Our Lady also appeared to St. John Bosco. We'll walk a


few blocks to the Spanish Steps and the Trevi Fountain, where a coin thrown over your shoulder will guarantee you another visit to Rome. The remainder of the day will

 be free for shopping or sightseeing. This evening we will enjoy a farewell dinner at a local restaurant.

≫ Day 13 – August 12: Rome / U.S.A.

Following breakfast, transfer to the airport to catch our return flight home.







will be celebrated, and St. Lawrence Outside the Walls which contains the tomb of St. Lawrence who was one of the first seven deacons of Rome martyred in 258. After lunch we will continue our exploration of Rome with a visit to the Renaissance section of the city. We will see the Basilica of Santa Maria Sopra Minerva, Pantheon, Piazza Navona with Bernini's famous fountains and Campo de' Fiori which is one of the most colorful street markets in Rome.

≫ Day 10 – August 9: Rome

This morning we will proceed to Castel Sant' Angelo which was built as Emperor Hadrian's mausoleum and was later used as the residence of Popes during times of turmoil. After seeing Castel Sant'Angelo from outside, we will journey on foot down Via della Conciliazione and traverse Pius XII Square through St. Peter's Square and finally enter the Holy Door into St. Peter's Basilica. We'll celebrate Mass in St. Peter's Basilica, followed by a tour including the Pieta and Adoration Chapel which St. John Paul II opened in 1981. Our guide will then take us through the Vatican Museum and the Sistine Chapel with its awesome frescoes painted by Michelangelo focusing especially on Eucharistic art and artifacts. In the afternoon, we will visit the Church of Santa Maria del Popolo and the Church of Santa Croce in Gerusalemme which contains relics of the Crucifixion. We will conclude the day with a visit to the Church of Santa Sabina all'Aventino which is the headquarters of the Dominican order.

→ Day 11 – August 10: Rome

This morning we will experience a highlight of our pilgrimage, attendance at the Papal Audience at St. Peter's (subject to the Holy Father's schedule). Join thousands of pilgrims from throughout the world to listen to the Holy Father and receive his blessing. In the afternoon our sightseeing includes visits to St. Mary Major Basilica, St. John Lateran, and the Holy Stairs.

➢ Day 12 − August 11: Rome

Our day will begin with a drive out along the Old Appian

Reservations and Payment: Tekton Ministries requires a deposit of \$300.00 per person at the time of booking. This deposit forms a part of your final payment which is due 75 days prior to departure. Reservations made within 74 days of departure must be accompanied by payment in full. Payments made by credit card will incur a convenience fee. Any reservations received within 45 days of departure will incur a late booking fee of \$100.00 per person. This pilgrimage is based upon a minimum of 21 total pilgrims. Surcharges may be assessed for a smaller group size.

Cancellations: All cancellations must be in writing. The following per person cancellation charges will apply in addition to any charges incurred by our suppliers: If canceled 91 days or more prior to departure, a \$50.00 administrative fee will be charged. If canceled 90 - 31 days prior to departure, \$150.00 will be charged. If canceled 30 - 15 days prior to departure, \$450.00 will be charged. If canceled 14 - 7 days prior to departure \$700.00 will be charged. No refunds will be made within 6 days of departure. In addition, once the airline tickets have been issued, 100% of the airfare is non-refundable unless you have been advised otherwise at the time of your booking.

Travel Documents: A passport which is valid for 6 months past the date of your return flight home is required of all U. S. citizens. However, U.S. citizens do not require visas for Italy. If you are not a U.S. citizen, please call to find out if you need a visa. Tekton Ministries is not responsible for individual visas or passports.

Hotels: Accommodations are based on double occupancy rooms with private facilities. A limited number of single rooms are available at the supplement quoted and should be requested at the time of booking.

Air Transportation: Air travel is in economy class on Alitalia. Fares are based upon levels in effect at the time of printing and fares and flight schedules are subject to change without notice.

Baggage: Each passenger is allowed one checked bag and one carryon. Tekton Ministries is not responsible for lost, damaged or stolen baggage.

Travel Insurance: We strongly recommend that you purchase comprehensive travel insurance for your trip. Registration information will be provided upon receipt of your deposit.

Not Included: Passport/visa fees, Airline taxes/fuel surcharges, currently \$639.30 per person (subject to change until the time of ticketing), gratuities t o tour manager, local guides, drivers, and hotel/restaurant staff, personal travel insurance, laundry, beverages and items not on the regular menu of included meals, excess baggage charges, optional sightseeing and expenses of a personal nature.

Refunds: Subject to the foregoing Cancellation Terms, upon cancellation of travel related services, all sums paid to Tekton Ministries/George's International Tours for such services will be promptly returned to the passenger, <u>provided</u> the passenger has not caused such cancellation and is not in violation of any of the terms and conditions previously, clearly and conspicuously disclosed and agreed to by the passenger. This refund provision does not apply where Tekton Ministries/George's International Tours has remitted the payment to another registered seller of travel or a carrier and they default in providing the agreed-upon transportation or service without providing a refund. In such a situation, Tekton Ministries/George's International Tours agrees to provide passenger with

- a written statement accompanied by a copy of the bank records establishing the disbursement of the payment, and if disbursed to a seller of travel, proof of their current registration.
- **Trust Account Disclosure:** California law requires certain sellers of travel to have a trust account or bond. George's International Tours has such a trust account.

Travel Consumer Restitution Corporation ("TCRC"): George's International Tours is a participant in the Travel Consumer Restitution Corporation ("TCRC"). You, the passenger, may request reimbursement from TCRC if George's International Tours was registered and participating in the TCRC at the time of sale and the passenger is located in California at the time of payment. Please be advised that passengers purchasing from outside of California are not covered by the TCRC. Eligible passengers may file a claim with TCRC if the passenger is owed a refund of more than \$50 for transportation or travel services which George's International Tours failed to forward to a proper provider or if such money was not refunded to you when required. The maximum amount, which may be paid by the TCRC to any one passenger is the total amount paid on behalf of the passenger to George's International Tours, not to exceed \$15,000. A claim must be submitted to the TCRC within six months after the scheduled completion date of the travel. A claim must include sufficient information and documentation to prove your claim and a \$35 processing fee. You must agree to waive your right to other civil remedies against a registered participating Seller of Travel for matters arising out of a sale for which you file a claim with the TCRC, if you were located in California at the time of the sale.
