ITINERARY

Day 1 - June 21: U.S.A. / Mexico City

Today marks the beginning of our pilgrimage as we depart on our flight to Mexico City. Upon arrival at the airport in Mexico City we will be met by our local guide and transfer to our centrally located hotel.

Day 2 - June 22: Mexico City

After breakfast this morning we will drive to the Plaza of the Three Cultures to see the ancient ruins and the place where Juan Diego was baptized. Continue to the Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe, the holiest place in the Western Hemisphere, for an introductory guided tour of the Basilica and the surrounding grounds, including the old Basilica, Tepeyac Hill Indian Church, the Church of the Well, and the Monument of the Offerings. Mass will be celebrated at one of the side altars. In the afternoon we will visit Mexico City's world famous Anthropological Museum. Then visit Chapultepec Park, the Don Quixote Fountain and Reforma Avenue. (B/D)

Day 3 - June 23: Mexico City

After breakfast this morning we will drive to Tulpetlac, the site of the 5th apparition to Saint Juan Diego's uncle, Juan Bernardino. Then proceed to the Monastery of Acolman where we will celebrate Mass. Continue on to Teotihuacan to visit the Pyramids of the Sun and Moon. Return to Mexico City. (B/D)

Day 4 - June 24: Mexico City / Puebla / Cuernavaca

This morning we drive outside of Mexico City to the Shrine of San Miguel del Milagro, the site of miraculous apparitions of St. Michael to Diego Lazaro in 1631. We will pray the St. Michael the Archangel prayer and visit the well of healing waters. We will then proceed to the Shrine and Sanctuary of Our Lady of Octolan. Here Our Lady appeared to Juan Diego Bernardino in 1541 and left her miraculous statue in a burnt tree. Our next stop will be in Puebla where we will pray at the Santo Domingo Church and celebrate Mass at the Capilla del Rosario. Then continue on to the colonial city of Cuernavaca for overnight. (B/D)

Day 5 - June 25: Cuernavaca / Taxco / Cuernavaca

This morning, we depart for Taxco, the famous silver-working town where we can buy silver artifacts and jewelry. There we will celebrate Mass at the world famous Santa Prisca Cathedral. We will then return to Cuernavaca and see the Cathedral, the Emmaus Monastery, and the Juarez Garden courtyards near the Cathedral. (B/D)

Day 6 - June 26: Cuernavaca / Mexico City

This morning we will depart Cuernavaca and visit the town of Tepotzotlan, which is famous for the Church of St. Francis Xavier before returning to Mexico City. Upon arrival in Mexico City we will visit the Metropolitan Cathedral, the Zocalo, the House of Tiles, the Palacio Nacional, and the Templo Mayor (outside visit). Then celebrate Mass at the Santo Domingo Church before proceeding to our hotel for check-in.(B/D)

Day 7 - June 27: Mexico City

After breakfast this morning we will return to the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe for a second visit. After celebrating Mass at one of the side altars we will visit the church on the top of Tepeyac Hill where St. Juan Diego collected the roses, we will have time for prayer, private devotions, and shopping for religious articles. We will then see Bl. Miguel Pro's relics in the Church of the Holy Family. This evening we will enjoy a festive farewell dinner at a local restaurant. (B/D)

Day 8 - June 28: Mexico City / U.S.A.

After breakfast we will transfer to the airport to catch our return flight home. (B)
